

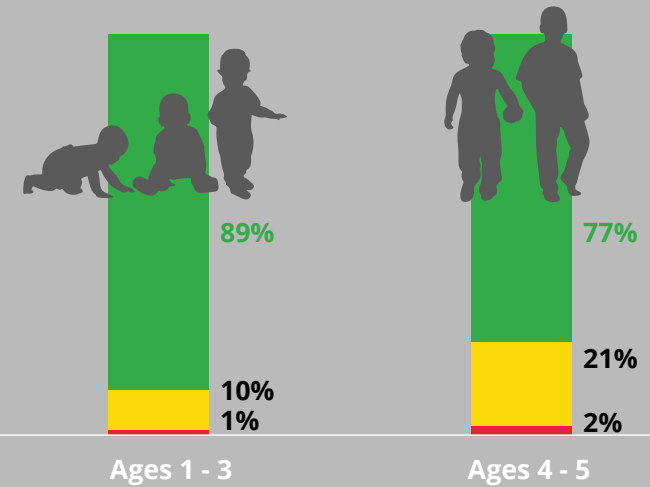

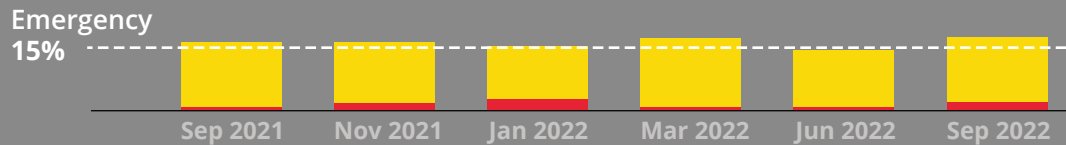

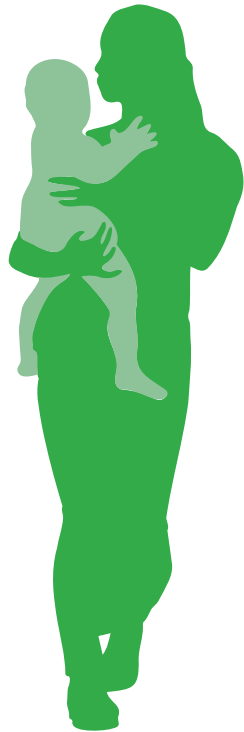
## Acute Malnutrition by Age Group
